MESSAGE NOTES

PROMISE ONE: A Servant's Heart, James 4:10; Philippians 2:5 – 11; Romans 13:1

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up. — James 4:10

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus ... but made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant ... He humbled Himself and became obedient to death — even death on a cross ... Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name. — Philippians 2:5 – 11

Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God. — Romans 13:1

PROMISE TWO: A Generous Heart, 2 Corinthians 9:6 – 8

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. — 2 Corinthians 9:6 – 8

PROMISE THREE: A Hopeful Heart, Romans 8:28 – 29

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose. For those God foreknew He also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of His Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. — Romans 8:28 – 29
