DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Re-read Psalm 1. What words stick out to you? Why?
- The verbs in verse 1 “walk, stand, sit” suggest an increasing comfort with sin or wickedness. Talk about your experience with sin or disobedience sneaking into your own life.
- Brian talked about associations, or the people whose voices we allow to inform our opinions and thoughts. Few of us just listen to openly sinful people, but discuss what happens when we take advice from the wrong people/persons.
- When you think about validation or approval, who are the people that SHOULD matter to you?
- Brian’s illustration of the house suggests there are some people who should stay on “the porch,” others in the living room, and others that belong in our “bedroom.” Talk about how you make distinctions as to who goes where in your life?
- Name the two or three people (you must have more than 1) that give you roots (ground you in identity and mission).
