Blueprints that Link God's character to Our Identity:

• Discover the Father's love through adoption.

... In love He predestined us for adoption to Himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will, — Ephesians 1:4 – 5 (ESV)

• Discover Christ's freedom through redemption.

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace, which He lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight ... — Ephesians 1:7 – 8 (ESV)

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit. — 1 Peter 3:18 (ESV)

• Discover the Spirit's power through the promise.

In Him you also, when you heard the Word of truth, the Gospel of your salvation, and believed in Him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, — Ephesians 1:13 (ESV)
