- How was the giving of the Holy Spirit in Acts 2 to the church a "disruptor" of incredible positive magnitude for followers of Christ?
- What was your biggest takeaway from Acts 2:1 12 and why?
- Read Acts 2:12. The disciples asked, "What does this mean?" If you were to answer that question in your own words, how would you have answered them?
- The coming of the Holy Spirit was a testimony of God's faithfulness as it was the fulfillment of many Old Testament promises. What is a promise of God that often reminds you of God's faithfulness in your life now?
- Read Romans 8:16. Being filled with the Spirit means that we shine for Christ, but it also means
  that God shines to us with His love as our Father. How have you seen God shining in someone's
  life recently? Why is it important to experience God's love and pleasure over us as His children?
- Read Acts 1:8. Why was it significant that when the Gospel was first shared in Jerusalem on the Day of Pentecost that it was shared in multiple languages all at once?
- The more we are in alignment with Christ's authority, the more we experience His power in life.
   What is an area of life that you are wrestling to align with God and experience more of His power in?
