OVERVIEW:

ENCOUNTER's Worship Ministry Intern position is an exciting opportunity for a young worship leader looking to develop heart, passion, and gifting for worship ministry. We are looking for an energetic, humble, and Christ-loving worship leader to join our team. The Worship Ministry Intern will assist the Worship Pastor & Team in an array of ways, including receiving exposure to weekly planning, scheduling, and preparation. This position will have the opportunity to both lead worship and lead the band/vocalist. This is a contracted position working approximately 15 hours per week. The specific number of hours required per week is flexible based on needs in worship ministry, the season of ministry, and the life situation of the intern.

Skills gained.

- **Volunteer Scheduling & Leadership:** Learn how to schedule volunteers and communicate with individuals to backfill any empty slots
- **Services music arrangement & set lists:** Learn how to select and arrange music & create set lists
- **Program training:** Learn a rudimentary knowledge of Ableton Live & Multi-tracks Playback

- Assist in preparing for rehearsal and weekend services
- Attend all Worship, Creative Arts Team, Service Planning, and All-Staff meetings
- Attend designated worship volunteer coffees and lunches alongside Worship Pastor
- Create & Assist in leading a worship band for our Celebrate Recovery (CR) ministry
- Perform other duties as assigned.
