Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are at Philippi, with the overseers and deacons: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. - Philippians 1:1 - 2 (ESV)

Choose joy by cultivating thankfulness before the Lord

I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, <u>always</u> in <u>every</u> prayer of mine for <u>you all</u> making my prayer with joy, ... — Philippians 1:3-4 (ESV)

... because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. — Philippians 1:5 (ESV)


· Choose joy by cultivating confidence in the Lord

And I am sure of this, that He who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. — Philippians 1:6 (ESV)

For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable. — Romans 11:29 (NAS)

It is right for me to feel this way about you all, because I hold you in my heart, for you are all partakers with me of grace, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. — Philippians 1:7 (ESV)

I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel, ... — Philippians 1:12 (ESV)




• Choose joy by cultivating love through the Lord

And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, ... – Philippians 1:9 (ESV)

... so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

- Read Philippians 1:12. Share an example of God using something difficult or challenging to proclaim the good news.
- Read Philippians 1:9. How does growing in God's love cultivate joy?
- Take some time to pray and give God thanks for the people He has placed in your life.
