LOVE OTHERS UP



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Discussion Starter: What is the best roller coaster you have ridden on and why?
- Read Philippians 2:1 4. What are some powerful messages from this well-known passage?
- Why does "humility in Christ" convey a sense of going down, only to be raised up again?
- Read Philippians 2:1. What is *"participation (fellowship) in the Spirit,"* and why is group life such an important part of this fellowship?
- Read Hebrews 12:2. Why is Christ the ultimate example of how the power of living a life of humility leads to joy?
- Where is God inviting you to encourage and love others? Why might this involve a step of sacrifice?
- Read John 14:16-18. Why is the Spirit coming alongside us and never leaving us such a powerful example of encouragement?
- Read Philippians 2:3. Restate this verse in a positive way: "*Do everything ...*" Where is God inviting you to live this out right now?
- Read Philippians 2:4. Why is the word "others" always important to remember when striving for a heart of humility?
- Pray and ask God to give you His heart for the "others" in your life.
