ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them how much you believe they have what it takes to have a great year this next school year.



Meal Time

At a meal, go around the table and have everyone say something good about the way God made each member of the family.



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What is something you admire about Jesus?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, the way You made us is amazing and wonderful! We praise You! Help us to remember every day that we are valuable because we are made in Your image!"

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Faith & Character Activities



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Talk About the Bible Story

Open the Bible together and read Ephesians 2:10; 1 Timothy 4:12 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Engagement Questions

- Why do you think God cares more about who you are than what you do?
- If God already prepared good works for you, how does that change your perspective?
- What are some things about the way God made you that God might use to show His love to others?

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Prayer

Dear God, thank You for creating us on purpose and for a purpose. Please show us the good works that You have prepared for us to do. Open our eyes to the big things and the simple acts of kindness You have for us throughout each day.

Weekly Parent Cues →

MEMORY VERSE

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Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them about something you've seen them do or say that showed they are growing in their relationship with God.



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: "What are you good at?" (If anyone has trouble answering the question, offer suggestions of things they do well.)



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid, "What do you think you would like to do when you grow up?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, You created us with a purpose. Help us to discover what You made us to do, and show us ways we can do those things for You."

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Open the Bible together and read Romans 8:28-29 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Engagement Questions

- When something hard happens, why is it difficult to believe that God could bring anything good out of it?
- How have hard moments actually prepared you for something bigger?
- When you can't see any "good" in a situation yet, what does trusting God actually look like in real life?

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Prayer

Dear God, thank You for using all things for Your good. Please help us to trust You when things are hard and know that You are in control and You can use all things.

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Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, encourage them that they can trust God with whatever they face today.



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: "What does it mean to trust God?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What is something challenging you are facing right now?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, help us to trust You with our whole lives. Help us to lean on You and to see the good that You might be doing when things are difficult."

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Open the Bible together and read John 4 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Engagement Questions

- Who are the people in your life who might feel judged by others? What would it look like to treat them the way Jesus did?
- How has Jesus changed your life?
- What are some ways we might accidentally value people the world's way instead of Jesus' way?

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Dear God, thank You for creating every single person. Help us to love like Jesus and remember that Jesus values everyone so we should too!

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Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, remind them that they are valuable to Jesus and so is everyone they will see today!



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: "How can we show people that they are valuable to God?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid, "Who do you think needs to feel valued by God?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, thank You for valuing me. Thank You for valuing each person on this earth. Please help me to live and love everyone the way You do."

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Open the Bible together and read Exodus 25:8-9; 39:42-43 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Engagement Questions

- Why do you think God didn't give all the same gifts to one person?
- How can comparing your gifts to someone else's stop you from using what God has given you?
- The Israelites gave their time, skills, and even their possessions. Which of those feels hardest for you to offer to God?

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Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, let them know you are praying for them today. (You may even want to ask them if there is something they want you to pray about.)



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: "What could we do together as a family to show God's love to others?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid, "When is a time you worked with others to build or do something awesome?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, we praise You for the way You made each person. Help us to work together and use our gifts to grow Your kingdom. Give us the strength to keep going even when we feel discouraged."

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
